OAVT 2016 Wage Survey

For the first time since the OAVT's wage survey began, the average hourly wage for RVTs in Ontario has pushed past the \$20 mark. Compared to \$19.82 in 2015, the average hourly wage for RVTs in 2016 was \$20.41.

Please look over some of the data we have compiled from the nearly 1,000 responses to the OAVT 2016 Wage Survey.

Extra Education

- The average wage for an RVT with their RLAT designation was \$26.16 an hour
- For RVTs with a B.Sc, the average wage was \$22.44 per hour
- RVTs with a VTS in Anesthesia & Analgesia saw an average wage of \$23.89; a VTS in Emergency & Critical Care saw an average of \$30.28

Perks & Benefits

- 62% of respondents say their employer pays for their OAVT dues
- 77% of respondents say their employer gives them free or discounted: pet food, animal medication and supplies, and/or animal exams, tests and surgeries
- 55% of respondents say their employer provides them with a clothing and/or shoe allowance; the same number of respondents say they receive health insurance
- 60% of respondents receive a CE allowance

The highs and lows

- Only 5% of respondents made less than \$15 per hour. Of that 5%:
 - half were between the ages of 18 and 25
 - 80% have been in the industry for four years or less
- Roughly 7% of respondents made more than \$30 per hour. Of that 7%:
 - 60% are between the ages of 35 and 50
 - 23% have additional credentials (besides RVT)
 - One third have been working in this industry for 13-19 years; another third have been working in this industry for 19-28 years
